On Wednesday, September 28, 2011 at 12:35 am, The Plymouth County Sheriff's Office received a call from Samantha Reeves of Seney stating her ex-boyfriend was in the area and had just slashed the tires on her friends' vehicle and when confronted by the friend, attempted to strike him with the vehicle he was driving. The suspect, Jeremy John Schiltz, age 21 of Remsen was located by officers at a residence in Remsen. Schiltz was arrested for criminal mischief in the fourth degree, a serious misdemeanor, and assault with a dangerous weapon, an aggravated misdemeanor. He was booked into the Plymouth county jail.

Damage to the four tires was estimated at 288.00.
